


The Grand Mesa Uncompahgre Gunnison (GMUG) National Forest Revision Plan

The GMUG Forest Plan revision is in the draft form, and the time is NOW for your input. This plan will direct how the US Forest Service manages the GMUG forests for the next 15 to 20 years. The GMUG covers over 2.9 million acres in 14 counties in western Colorado.

The Forest Service is looking for comments that are specific to what YOU want to see in YOUR Forests.

- **Do you have a favorite hike, ski trail, mountain bike trail, hunting area?** Tell the Forest Service where it is and how you'd like it to look in the future.
- How should different types of recreation and wildlife management be balanced? What specific plants, animals and habitats need more protection for the years to come?
- How much Wilderness do we need,,, and where? What about Wild & Scenic Rivers?
- How much of the Forests should be designated as "suitable for timber production" or listed as "General Forest" (with few management restrictions)?
